

ISA CropCare BV Participates in Successful Agricultural Trade Mission to Indonesia



From **16 to 19 June 2025**, ISA CropCare BV took part in the **Dutch economic mission to Indonesia**, focused on strengthening bilateral cooperation in sectors such as agri-food, water, and maritime logistics. The mission, led by the Dutch government, brought together more than 100 companies, knowledge institutes, and government bodies, with events held in **Jakarta and Semarang**.

Focus of the Mission

The mission aimed to facilitate partnerships and investment opportunities between Dutch and Indonesian stakeholders, particularly in the areas of sustainable agriculture, food security, and technological innovation. With growing global challenges in food production and environmental sustainability, Dutch expertise in smart, efficient, and residue-free



agriculture attracted strong interest from local authorities and private sector stakeholders in Indonesia.

ISA CropCare's Contribution

ISA CropCare BV joined the mission to introduce its range of **green and residue-free crop protection products** to the Indonesian market. The company's innovative solutions drew considerable attention during the matchmaking sessions and company visits. In particular, **Siltac SF**, a residue-free insecticide based on 3D polymer technology, sparked significant interest among local **distributors and agricultural retailers**.



The response from Indonesian partners was highly positive, with many recognizing the urgent need for safe and effective alternatives to conventional pesticides. Several key contacts were established during the mission, leading to follow-up video meetings just a week later to explore concrete opportunities for market entry and distribution in Indonesia.

Promising Outlook

The mission was a clear success for ISA CropCare BV. The company returned with a strong network of potential partners and a clear roadmap to start **building its presence in the Indonesian agricultural sector**. Discussions are now ongoing to set up local collaborations and trials, with the goal of introducing ISA CropCare's products across key growing regions in the country.
